5. Exos ludiques

Expressing likes/dislikes

Draw two symbols on the board: a heart to represent the phrase "j'aime ça" and a heart with an X through it to represent the phrases "je n'aime pas ça". Hold up pictures of foods which will elicit strong likes and dislikes. Start with all time favorites like ice cream, candy, chocolate, oranges, grapes, etc. Begin by pointing to the heart symbol. Smile and say "j'aime ça" (I like this/that). By the time you say ça be pointing to the thing that you like. Have the students work with a partner or in a small group taking turns pointing to an item they like and saying j'aime ça. Then move to the negative. Point to the symbol of the heart with an X through it. Put on a yucky face and say "je n'aime pas ça" (I don't like this/that) and point to something you do not like. Repeat the above process moving from item to item and then letting the students have a chance to express dislike. You can have the students count in French how many of their peers like the foods shown.
